Yorkshire making rally driver series

MICHAEL J. BIRD. creator of series such as The Outsider for Yorkshire and The Lotus Eaters and Maelstrom for the BBC, has devised a six-part drama series about rally-driving for Yorkshire. The series, called The Winning Streak, will be shown in one-hour slots on the ITV network, probably in the late autumn.

The Winning Streak is being produced and partly written by Michael Russell, former script editor of Yorkshire's Emmerdale Farm. The directors are Frank W. Smith and Richard Holthouse. Michael Glynn, producer of The Outsider and The Glory Boys, is executive producer. The other writer is Tim Vaughan.

The series is about a young man's ambition to become a champion rallydriver. His parents, Bernard Savage, played by Leslie Sands and his wife Frances, played by Dinah Sheridan, run a successful motor business called Savage Motors.

Benedick Blythe plays David Savage, the son, and Shaun Scott, who played lack Fairchild in Brass, plays David's older brother Paul. This is Benedick Blythe's first major role for television.

Also in the cast are Shelagh McLeod, Laura Davenport, Jane Morant, Tony Melody and Michael Cashman.

Currently in production at Yorkshire is a six-part drama serial about rally driving called The Winning Streak. It is for showing on the ITV network, probably this autumn in six one-hour slots.

The serial was devised by Michael J. Bird, creator of series such as The Lotus Eaters and the recently shown Maelstrom, and is being produced and partly written by Michael Russell, former scriptwriter of Yorkshire's Emmerdale Farm. The other scriptwriter is Tim Vaughan.

The directors are Frank W. Smith and Richard Holthouse, with Michael Glynn, producer of Yorkshire's The Glory Boys, as executive producer.

The story is about a young man's ambition to become a champion rally driver. It is also about conflicts within the Savage family, the wealthy owners of a garage business. Benedick Blythe plays the young man David Savage. It is his first major role for television.
